TEDxJacksonHole: Tickets Going Live

Jackson Hole, Wyo. - June 30, 2017 - As June comes to a close, ticket counters will open for the 2017 **TEDxJacksonHole "Out of Darkness"** event.

Tickets can be purchased online starting at **noon on Saturday, July 1**, through the Center for the Arts box office at www.jhcenterforthearts.org, in person during regular box office hours at 265 S. Cache St., or by calling (307) 733-4900.

TEDxJacksonHole – sponsored by Jackson Hole WILD – will take place on Aug. 22 – one day after the solar eclipse with the theme “Out of Darkness.” Tickets are \$40 for orchestra seating and \$20 for balcony seating (with an additional \$2 processing fee). The event, which has sold out for the past six years, begins promptly at 7 p.m.

Come early for a reception from 5-7 p.m. in the Center for the Arts theater lobby and amphitheater to meet speakers and artists. Food. Drink. Music. Art. Conversation.

In the spirit of ideas worth spreading, TEDx is a program of local, self-organized events that bring people together to share a TED-like experience. At a TEDx event, TED Talks video and live speakers combine to spark deep discussion and connection. These local, self-organized events are branded TEDx, where x = independently organized TED event. The TED Conference provides general guidance for the TEDx program, but individual TEDx events are self-organized. (Subject to certain rules and regulations.)

TED is a nonprofit organization devoted to Ideas Worth Spreading. Started as a four-day conference in California 30 years ago, TED has grown to support its mission with multiple initiatives. The two annual TED Conferences invite the world's leading thinkers and doers to speak for 18 minutes or less. Many of these talks are then made available, free, at TED.com. TED

speakers have included Bill Gates, Jane Goodall, Elizabeth Gilbert, Sir Richard Branson, Nandan Nilekani, Philippe Starck, Ngozi Okonjo-Iweala, Sal Khan and Daniel Kahneman.

The annual TED Conference takes place each spring in Vancouver, British Columbia. TED's media initiatives include TED.com, where new TED Talks are posted daily; the Open Translation Project, which provides subtitles and interactive transcripts as well as translations from volunteers worldwide; the educational initiative TED-Ed. TED has established the annual TED Prize, where exceptional individuals with a wish to change the world get help translating their wishes into action; TEDx, which supports individuals or groups in hosting local, self-organized TED-style events around the world, and the TED Fellows program, helping world-changing innovators from around the globe to amplify the impact of their remarkable projects and activities.
